- CCAF has funding to cover co-payment, coinsurance and deductibles for chemotherapy or targeted treatment medications only.
You, a family member or a representative can contact us directly and a co-payment specialist can assist you. Office hours are 9 a.m.–7 p.m. (EST) Monday through Thursday, and 9 a.m.–5 p.m. (EST) on Friday.
- They can refer you to other resources that may help such as drug company patient assistance programs and state prescription programs.
